



EAST FORK; The East Fork is an excellent wading stream. The upper portions offer spectacular Tenkara fishing. There is one unimproved launch/takeout at Spring Gulch Campground on the lower, portion we strongly advise against any floating. The river is small and frequently blocked by logjams or downed trees and is very dangerous. Numerous opportunities exist to gain access for wade fishing from Highway 93.

Approximate mileage to locally used East Fork Access Points.

MM 24.7 Lat 45° 55'49.7"N Long 114° 07'25.5"W	Conner Bridge Turn west onto Conner Cutoff road from Highway 93 S. Park on shoulder access on sides of bridge.
MM 15.6 Lat 45° 51'31"N Long 114° 01'23"W	Spring Gulch Campground NFS campground on east side of highway.
MM 14.3 Lat 45° 20.989'N Long 113° 59.043'W	Sula/Cameron Creek Turn east onto East Fork Road .
MM 1.1 Lat 45° 51.474'N Long 114° 01.366'W	Edwards Bridge Turn south on Camp Creek Road , then east on Edwards Road 0.4 miles
MM 3.5 45° 51'13.2"N 113° 55'35.9"W	Wetzstone Bridge Parking just past intersection on south. Access and old unsafe ramp NE from parking area. Do not try and float this area.
MM 10 Lat 45° 53.765'N Long 113° 49.23'W	Jennings Campground On south side of East Fork Road .
MM 12.9 Lat 45° 54.531'N Long 113° 46.096'W	A.W. Francis Picnic Area & Fishing Access On south side of East Fork Road .
MM 15.5 Lat 45° 54'26.6"N Long 113° 42'14.2"W	Trailhead 2 miles on Little East Fork Road (gravel) to trailhead parking.
